Certified Clinical Research Professional Re-Certification Application - Continuing Education (CE) Units - Explanation

Certification of Clinical Research Professionals by SoCRA is based on a continuing process of professional experience and education. This program is dedicated to providing recognition and validation of the professional growth of the individual "CCRP" to the healthcare community.

A SoCRA member wishing to re-certify must be a member in good standing with a current certification. Re-certification is required every three years and the candidate 1) must have completed 45 hours of Continuing Education applicable to their work in clinical research during the current three years of certification, and 2) must successfully complete a self-administered knowledge test that will be included with the three-year re-certification reminder package.

Because of the diversity of SoCRA membership, a specific listing of approved CE programs will not be developed. Members applying for re-certification will be asked to sign an affidavit that verifies an accumulation of 45 hours of Continuing Education applicable to their work in clinical research. One credit is given for taking the re-certification quiz, 22 credit hours or more must relate to clinical research regulations, policy, operations, etc., and the balance may relate to your work in research (therapy, treatment, etc.).

It is the responsibility of the applicant to maintain copies of certificates of completion/attendance, **OR** program descriptions/agendas and some form of verification of attendance. If a formal certificate of completion or attendance is not available, please send one form of verification with the meeting description or agenda. Verification may include any one of the following forms:

- 1) letter from meeting host which should verify attendance and hours of CE, 2) copy of official meeting sign-in sheet,
- 3) personal name tag with logo or name of program host, 4) notice of grade received or class transcript

Examples of items that DO NOT qualify as proof of meeting attendance include: notification of meeting, flight schedules, boarding passes, hotel receipts. Such items cannot assure an auditor that a candidate attended a program.

A random audit of documentation submitted for CE credit will be conducted each year.

Examples of acceptable programs include:

- Workshops at research bases or pharmaceutical company meetings encompassing subjects appropriate to clinical research (one classroom hour = one CE hour).
- Programs developed and/or endorsed by SoCRA (one classroom hour = one CE hour).
- Seminars, conferences, programs including web-based training, or institutes (applying to clinical research) that contribute to education or professional advancement (one classroom hour = one CE hour).
- College, university, or accredited independent study courses relevant to work in clinical research (one semester hour college credit = 10 hours of CE for SoCRA re-certification).
- Grand rounds, tumor boards, and Institutional Review Board meetings (maximum of two hours of CE may be credited from all of these areas combined, per year).
- Investigator Meetings – 2 hours of CE per meeting; maximum 6 CE per three year period. Requires agenda and letter signed by supervisor stipulating hours spent on GCP.
- The following types of CE may account for (up to) five hours of re-certification credit per year (one hour of this activity = one CE hour). After completion of this type of CE, the applicant must write a half page (250 word) summary and keep that summary on file with other CE documentation for audit purposes.
 - Audio and video tapes of CE programs related to clinical research (state, chapter or association meetings, area or local chapter meetings, etc.). Tapes must be one hour in length for each hour claimed.
 - Reading of journal articles, self study programs and professional study groups may be claimed in one-hour increments for each hour spent on the activity. *SoCRA Source* articles with completed self-test exams do not require summaries.
- Active participation in SoCRA as an elected officer, committee chair or active committee member, for SoCRA or a SoCRA chapter. This type of activity may account for (up to) three hours of re-certification credit over three years (one year of such participation = one CE hour, maximum one CE hour credit per year). 070530A rev 090305
