CCRP QUICK FACTS

WHY CCRP?

- One certification, CCRP, for all clinical research professionals
- No need to obtain multiple certifications when you transition to varying roles in the clinical research arena. The scope of the Certification Program is based on the principles of Good Clinical Practice, including the US Code of Federal Regulations, ICH GCP E6, and the Ethical Principles that guide clinical research (Belmont Report, Declaration of Helsinki and the Nuremberg Code.) One certification covers: human clinical research of pharmaceuticals, biologics, medical devices and behavioral research within the US or internationally.

CCRP QUICK FACTS

- Available to non-members and to members (to members at a reduced cost)
- Available to all persons working in clinical research (whether they are independent or affiliated with research institutions, CROs, SMOs, sponsors, or government) including:
 - clinical investigators
 - coordinators
 - data managers
 - monitors
 - auditors
 - research nurses
 - pharmacists
 - project managers
 - statisticians
 - government investigators and regulators
 - IRB and regulatory staff
 - other clinical research professionals
- Year round testing
- SOCRA will administer an exam at your site for 15 or more candidates
- Administered independently by the Certification Committee
- Applicants must meet eligibility requirements
- Three year certification period
- Installment Payment Plan Available
- Complimentary SOCRA membership given to CCRPs
